

Cookie notice as extracted from website:

This Cookie Notice was last updated on 28 June 2024 and applies to visitors located in the European Economic Area and the United Kingdom.

1. Introduction

Our website, <https://action3fsgs.com> (hereinafter: "the website") uses cookies and other related data-collection technologies (for convenience all technologies are referred to as "cookies"). Cookies are also placed by third parties we have engaged. We are committed to protecting your privacy and ensuring compliance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR") and the ePrivacy Directive as well as the UK GDPR and the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations ("PECR"). In the document below we inform you about the nature and the use of cookies on our website.

2. What are cookies?

A cookie is a small simple file that contains information useful to a website. When you browse a website, cookies are generated by a web server, sent along with pages of the website, and stored by your browser on the hard drive of your computer or another device that is being used to access the website. The information stored therein may be returned to our servers or to the servers of the relevant third parties during a subsequent visit.

3. What are scripts?

A script is a piece of program code that is used to make our website function properly and interactively. This code is executed on our server or on your device.

4. What is a web beacon?

A web beacon (or a pixel tag) is a small, invisible piece of text or image on a website that is used to monitor traffic on a website. In order to do this, various data about you is stored using web beacons.

5. Types of cookies

There are different types of cookies we may use. They can be distinguished on the basis of origin, function or lifespan.

5.1 Cookies can be categorized according to their origins as follows:

- **First-party cookies:** They are directly set, sent to your device, managed by the website that the user is visiting and stored on the same domain. They allow the website to collect user analytics data and personalize user experience. They typically store functional information such as language settings and items that have been added to an online shopping cart.
- **Third-party cookies:** They are set by third-party websites other than the website you are directly visiting. They belong to a domain other than the one displayed in the browser, and they are shared on third-party domains that use the same tracking code, with the primary

function of tracking visitors' activities online. They are companies that process the data obtained through them.

5.2 Cookies can also be categorized according to their functions as follows:

- **Technical or strictly necessary cookies:** Technical cookies allow the user to browse a website, a platform, or an app, and to use the various options or services on it. For example, they may serve to control traffic, identify data or session, and provide access to restricted-access sections or content. They are necessary for the functions of the website. We may place these cookies without your consent.
- **Functional cookies:** Some cookies enhance the usability of a website by offering basic features to ensure that certain parts of the website work and that your user preferences such as your preferred language remain known. By placing functional cookies, we make it easier for you to visit our website. This way, you do not need to repeatedly enter the same information when visiting our website and, for example, the items remain in your shopping cart until you have paid. We ask your permission to place functional cookies. Not accepting functional cookies may cause slow website performance or poorly adapted recommendations.
- **Statistics or performance cookies:** We use statistics cookies to optimize the website experience for our users. With these statistics cookies we get insights in the usage of our website (e.g., which pages are visited the most). We ask your permission to place statistics cookies.
- **Marketing or tracking cookies:** Marketing cookies are cookies or any other form of local storage, used to create user profiles to display advertising or to track the user's behavior on this website or across several websites for similar marketing purposes. We ask your permission to place marketing cookies. If you do not allow these cookies, you will experience less targeted advertising.

5.3 Cookies can also be categorized according to their lifespans as follows:

- **Session cookies:** They are stored in the memory of the device only during your browsing session to recognize and link your actions during the browsing session. When you go to the login page, these temporary cookies will be created to determine whether or not your browser accepts cookies. These cookies are automatically deleted from your device when the browser is closed (*i.e.*, when a session is "killed").
- **Persistent cookies:** They are stored on your device between sessions and remain in your browser after the browser is closed. They can be used to remember your preferences or actions on a website.

6. Placed cookies

Our website uses technical cookies, functional cookies, statistics cookies and marketing cookies. Cookies in no way give us access to your device or any information other than the data you choose to share with us. Concretely, these cookies help to improve the functioning of the Website and in particular can be used for the following:

- [Facilitating users' connection to the website;

- Analyzing traffic to the website;
- Monitoring users' browsing behavior;
- Recognizing users' devices;
- Improving the efficiency of the website;
- ...]

Please note that we do not have any control over how the information stored via third-party cookies is used nor do we have access to such information. Please refer to the respective cookie notices of the third-party service providers for more information.

7. Consent

When you visit our website for the first time, we will show you a pop-up with an explanation about cookies. 7.1 Manage your consent settings

The options in your preference menu include:

Strictly necessary **Always active**

These are the cookies necessary for the website to function and therefore cannot be disabled. They are most used in response to an action by you that requests a service to be performed, such as setting your privacy preferences or filling out contact forms.

Functional

These cookies enable the website to enhance functionality and personalization by offering additional functions and personal settings based on your interaction with our site. They may be set by us or by third-party service providers of services that we have added to our pages. If you do not allow these cookies, some or all of the services may not function properly. If you do not allow these cookies, some or all of the services may not function properly.

Statistics

The technical storage or access that is used exclusively for statistical purposes. They help us to understand which pages are the most and least popular and how visitors move around our site, *etc.*

Marketing

The technical storage or access is required to create user profiles to send advertising, or to track the user on a website or across several websites for similar marketing purposes.

8. Enabling/disabling and deleting cookies

You can use your internet browser to automatically or manually delete cookies. You can also specify that certain cookies may not be placed. Another option is to change the settings of your internet browser so that you receive a message each time a cookie is placed.
